ALWAYS READY is more than a catchy saying for the paramedics, nurses and emergency medical technicians at REMSA and Care Flight. For 35 years, REMSA has provided mobile and emergency medical care to the region's 1.5 million citizens and the 5 million people who visit the area every year.

As a critical part of the region's public safety and healthcare infrastructure, REMSA must be **ALWAYS READY** and able to ensure business and operational continuity-including medical 9-1-1 dispatch, ground and air ambulance response in the event of a natural or manmade disaster.

Our region requires a wide variety of mobile healthcare options. REMSA's Search and Rescue, Wildland Fire and Tactical EMS teams support technical rescues, law enforcement and firefighters in their specialized work across our region.

The REMSA Mobile Operations Center is fully outfitted with unique EMS specifications and requirements to fully support a variety of emergency situations. This vehicle can support special events, special teams assignments and serve as a medical 9-1-1 dispatch back-up in the event of a disaster.

- Medical 9-1-1 dispatch stations for radio communications, paramedic ambulance deployment, emergency medical dispatch call-taking and air asset coordination
